CHRONOLOGICAL NARRATIVE
COMBAT OPERATIONS
OCTOBER 1944

During the month of October 1944, the 3rd Bombardment Group flew a total of 39 combat missions which involved a total of 309 sorties. A total of 1,639 bombs weighing a total of 167.35 tons were dropped on enemy installations, supplies, airdromes and personnel. A total of 271,210 rounds of .50 calibre ammunition were expended in strafing (1)(2).

At the beginning of the month the Group had a total of 60 A-20's assigned and 52 of them were available for combat; also one B-25C, one B-25D, three B-25J's, one C-47B-1 and one A-20G. There were 92 combat crews assigned to the group and 66 of them were available for combat duty. At the ending of the month there were 64 A-20's in the Group with 56 available for duty and one B-25C, one B-25D, five B-25J's, one C-47B-1 and two A-20H's. There were 94 combat crews on the 31st assigned to the Group with 88 of them available for combat duty (3).

The missions of the month were centered around the Western part of Dutch New Guinea. The three main enemy stronghold strikes were Uтарom, Babo and Sawar. There has been no enemy air activity in these places but the strips were bombed to make sure they were unserviceable for use. Many fires were started in these areas and several huts hit and destroyed.

The first day of October saw the Group up at Uтарom strip in Dutch New Guinea. The planes reached the assigned target and dropped their bombs. Two runs were made over the target. The B-25 leading the mission was unable to drop its bombs so the following A-20's dropped their bombs at random covering the target very well. Results were unobserved, however, and damage could not be assessed. Propaganda leaflets were dropped (4).

The following two days the four squadrons were released for maintenance and training (5)(6).

On the 4th day three squadrons were ordered to strafe ack positions and targets of opportunity near Babo in Dutch New Guinea. However, the weather was bad and the planes were all forced to return to the base (1).

The fifth day of the month, the Group was ordered to attack Sawar and vicinity. It was reported that there were troop concentrations in that area. The entire target area was well covered by bombing and strafing. One large fire was started with black smoke and a series of explosions following. Several other smaller fires were started in fuel dumps and stores areas. Several huts were hit by bomb bursts and strafing and were destroyed (2).

The mission of the 6th was a photo mission to Utarom strips. A complete coverage was made by the planes (3).

On the 7th the Group was released for maintenance and training and practice formation flying and bombing was carried out (4).

Three squadrons were ordered to hit Utarom on the 8th but the A-20's were unable to get through due to weather and so the three B-25's with the mission continued on and dropped bombs on the target area but were unable to determine what damage had been done on the drome (5).

They following day was another day of rest. All squadrons were released for maintenance and training (6).

It had been reported that there was a Jap Headquarters and an enemy bivouac area in the Sarmi district and two squadrons were ordered to bomb and strafe them. The 10th of October these two squadrons went to the designated area and dropped their bombs in the target area and strafed the entire place. Several small fires were started and many huts destroyed (7).

The 11th all squadrons were again released for maintenance and training (8).

Again on the 12th saw the two squadrons back to Sarmi area. Bombs were dropped and the entire area was well strafed. Five shacks were claimed to have been hit and destroyed. One fuel dump was believed to have been hit by tracers as there was an explosion and a large fire resulted. Two other fires were started on the beach just west of the road and one fire was started in the area near the CP. One plane dropped its bombs through the CP with unobserved results (1).

The following six days, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18, the Group was either released for maintenance and training or the scheduled missions were cancelled due to the weather.

On the 19th two squadrons were ordered to hit Utarom again. One bombing run was made over the target and the bomb coverage was considered ~~with~~ ^{good} large clusters striking in the intersection of the strips, also on the south end of the strip and at the north end. Ack ack positions were also hit and one small fire was started (2).

There was a photo run on the 20th to Utarom (3).

The mission for the 21st was cancelled due to weather.

The scene of attack on the 22nd was Sawar Village in Dutch New Guinea. Many single ship passes were made over the target dropping their bombs in the entire area. Bombs were seen to fall in the Jap defense area near the river. One large fire with dense white smoke was started near the southwest side of the road. Three fuel fires were started, one hut, possibly containing ammunition, and one truck in the Bageiserwar Village were set on fire by strafing (4).

Three of the squadrons were ordered on the 23rd to hit Orai River area near the Sarmi Village. The entire area was well strafed and bombed. Several small black smoke fires were started and huts were seen to blow into the air from the bombs (5).

The Group was released for maintenance and training on the 24th day of the month (6).

The target for the 25th was the fuel dump along the Orai River north of Sarmi. At least five fires were started in the target area, four of which were of a short duration. One large fire was started in the concentration of fuel drums in the dump area. The entire area was well strafed and the bombing was assessed as excellent (1).

Utaron was again the scene of attack on the 26th. Two squadrons made their run over the target and dropped bombs but were unable to see results due to the low clouds over the target area (2).

The following missions for the month were either cancelled or turned back due to the weather. The other days the group was released for maintenance and training (3).

The Group does not claim any credit for the destruction of Japanese planes or sinking of enemy ships.

ADMINISTRATION
OCTOBER 1944

During the month of October 1944, the 3rd Bombardment Group, composed of Group Headquarters and the four squadrons - 8th, 13th, 89th and 90th - was stationed at Hollandia, Dutch New Guinea, APO 565. The personnel on the first day of October consisted of 183 officers and 1036 enlisted men. On the last day of the month there were 184 Officers and 1049 Enlisted Men; an increase of one officer and 13 Enlisted Men. (1)

From orders of higher headquarters all furloughs were frozen for the month and no one left for furlough from headquarters.

October was a month for promotions. Due to vacancies caused by men leaving for the States on rotation nearly every Enlisted Man in headquarters received an advancement in grade. Three lieutenants were advanced to captains: William D. Blair (Ordnance section), Jack H.S. Cates (Materiel Section)(2) and Charles D. Pryor (Communications Section)(3). The following Enlisted Men were promoted: to Master Sergeant: David Finney and Harold Larson; to Technical Sergeant: Nelson L. Anderson, Donald H. George and Lester L. There have been several changes in the group effecting several departments. They include: Capt. Jack Cates appointed Group Executive S-4 Officer and later changed to Supply General S-4 per VOCCO (5). At the end of the month he was appointed Conservation and Reclamation officer in addition to his other duties (3). Major Charles Howe was named Air Inspector Deputy Commander, taking the place of Major Robert Dow who went home (5). Capt. Nicholas Peters was assigned to headquarters from the 8th Squadron and will act as Group Surgeon (6). 1st Lt. Edgar L. Patton came into the organization from Fifth Air Force and assigned to the Group as Chaplain in place of Chaplain Howard Johnson who was transferred to Fifth Air Force, 308th Bomb Wing (7). Major Gerald Prokopovitz was transferred to the organization from the 90th Squadron and will act as Assistant Operations officer (4). 1st Lt. George Magowan was appointed Assistant Group Communications Officer (4). 1st Lt. Clifton W. Phillips was appointed Assistant Intelligence Officer with additional duties in Public Relations (7). Capt. Robert Spieth was appointed Mess Officer (6). 2nd Lt. Earl A. Fast was assigned to the organization from Fifth Bomber Command and will act as Group Medical Administrative Officer (8). Colonel John P. Henebry returned to the Group from the States and will resume Group Commander and Lt. Col. Richard Ellis relieved to go home.

The Group Commander during the month of October was Lt. Col. Richard H. Ellis. He was a veteran pilot of the Grim Reapers and has led the Group on many important missions against the enemy. One of the most outstanding missions is the mission against the Boela oil fields in Ceram where much damage was done against the enemy. He has been awarded the Silver Star, Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters and the Purple Heart. He has 141 combat missions to his credit.

On the 30th of the month per orders of Fifth Air Force, the new authorized strength of this organization after withdrawal of personnel allotment table 117, is 27 Officers, 1 Warrant Officer and 86 Enlisted Men.
